A Message from the Pastor

Some of you may have noticed that we have a new **ROMAN MISSAL** on our Altar. The **Roman Missal** is the book containing the prescribed prayers, chants, and instructions for the celebration of Mass in the Roman Catholic Church. Published first in Latin under the title *Missale Romanum*, the text is then translated and, once approved by a *recognitio* by the **Vatican Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments**, is published in modern languages for use in local churches throughout the world. To accommodate the ongoing evolution and development of the Liturgy, new editions of the *Missale Romanum* were promulgated by Popes for use in the Church, most recently in 2002 by Saint John Paul II.

Our copy was sorely in need of replacement. Through the generosity of our Pastor emeritus, Rev. Charles F. Kelly, we now have a brand new copy of the **Roman Missal**. Dedicated to his parents William and Anne Kelly, Fr. Kelly confirms them to be "the source of his vocation", and donates the Missal in their memory. Thank you Fr. Kelly for all the love and care you have always had for this Parish, and for being a part of our St. Ambrose family. We are blessed.

For the 100th anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima in Portugal, Pope Francis has decided to grant a plenary indulgence opportunity throughout the entire anniversary year, which began November 27, 2016, and will end November 26, 2017. To obtain the plenary indulgence, the faithful must also fulfill the ordinary conditions:

and pray for the Holy Father.**

Those seeking an indulgence must also pray an Our Father, recite the Creed, and invoke Our Lady of Fatima. These individuals can pray in front of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima and must spiritually unite themselves to the jubilee celebrations on the days of the apparitions, the 13th of each month, between May and October 2017. They also must "offer to merciful God with confidence, through Mary, their prayers and sufferings or sacrifices they make in their own lives".
